Curated by TCLF during the centennial of Dan Kiley's Birth (2013), *The Landscape Architecture of Dan Kiley* exhibition features nearly 50 newly commissioned photographs of 27 of Kiley's more than 1,000 designs including: the Miller House and Garden, Columbus, IN; the Art Institute of Chicago South Garden, IL; and the Ford Foundation Atrium, NYC, NY. Expanded for this Brooklyn installation, the show includes richly produced video of former Kiley employees (Rich Haag, Joe Karr and Harriett Pattison) as well as an epilogue dedicated to the recent revitalization of the Ford Foundation Atrium.

In tandem with the *Landslide®* program, TCLF periodically produces traveling photographic exhibitions that illustrate the year's thematic compendium of threatened and at-risk sites. Each exhibition features newly commissioned photography, narratives about the sites and theme being explored, and ways for the public to get involved.
